## **Autocross –9am -3pm**

Day 1 of Shelbyfest autocross will be hosted Thursday May 6th, by Gateway Classic Mustang, BFGoodrich, and the Ford Performance Racing School. It will be held at the Hyde Park Fire Training facility located at 2304 Hyde Park Road in Jefferson City. There will be open autocross, but those who wish, may receive instruction from the trained instructors from Gateway Performance Suspension. What does it cost for you to participate in the autocross? \$25 per car, or if more than one driver will be using a car, the cost is \$25 per driver. You may purchase autocross credentials in advance at [www.shelbyfest.net](http://www.shelbyfest.net) or at the autocross.
